Knowledge of Latin is essential; familiarity of Classical Arabic would be an asset, but not necessary. Applicants should have high attention to detail and be confident using learning technology, especially Canvas. Work hours will average about 12 to 16 per week but this will vary depending on the immediate needs of the course, so applicants will need to be somewhat flexible with their time.
